JACK SHARMAN QUOTED ABOUT MUELLER REPORT IN LAW360 AND NEW YORK DAILY NEWS

Lightfoot, Franklin & White LLC partner **Jack Sharman** was quoted in two media outlets in the past week after special counsel Robert Mueller submitted his report to the U.S. Attorney General on Russian election interference and possible collusion with President Trump's 2016 campaign.
