JACK SHARMAN QUOTED IN UNIVERSITY BUSINESS ARTICLE ON DEI EXECUTIVE ORDERS AND HIGHER EDUCATION

He was special counsel to the House Banking Committee during its Whitewater investigation of President Bill Clinton in the 1990s. Currently, he serves as special counsel to the Office of the Georgia Secretary of State relating to inquiries into the 2020 presidential election.
